

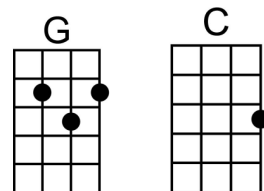

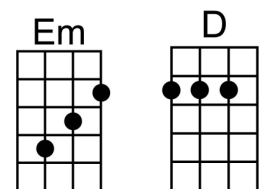

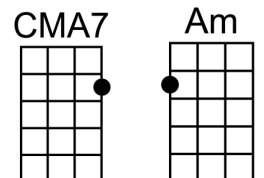


2. Un-[C]-resting, un-[D]-hasting and [C] silent as [G] light

Your [Am] clouds which are [Em7] fountains of [D] goodness and [G] love

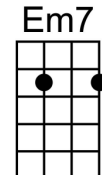
